

Resolution 2009-3

TOWN OF GREEN BAY

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has placed levy limits on towns, villages, cities and counties under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes:

Whereas, Sec. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes limits the local levy to a percentage increase no more than the greater of (a) 3% of the local levy for the previous year or (b) a percentage equal to the percentage change in equalized value due to new construction less improvements removed; which for the Town of Green Bay is 1.721 percentage;

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Green Bay, Brown County believes it is in the town's interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 3%.

Whereas, the Town of Green Bay levy was \$282,410 for the tax levy in 2008 (collected in 2009); and further whereas, the state limit would limit the increase to \$8,472 for a total allowable town tax levy of \$290,882.

Now Therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Green Bay, Brown County does hereby resolve and orders as follows:

1. The town board hereby supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2009(to be collected in 2010) to exceed the state levy limit by \$138,192 amount.
2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2009 (to be collected in 2010) by 51.933 percentage, which would increase the town levy by \$146,664 over the past year's levy, for a total town tax levy of \$429,074 shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on November 10, 2009.
