PUBLIC NOTICE

REGARDING SNOW PLOWING

All homeowners and snowplow contractors should be aware that they can be cited for placing obstructions, including snow, on the roadway.

Snow left out in the road by homeowners or private snow plowers is a road hazard. Snow should never be plowed onto or across the roadway. The proper way to plow a driveway is to start at the mouth of the drive and plow in. There should be a designated area to store snow in your yard.

Another danger is when snow is pushed across the road and piled on the berm. As the winter progresses these piles work their way out into the road. This hard-packed snow can push a snow plow across the centerline into on-coming traffic.
